HA2023 Check Payment Policy

Check payments for conference registration fees should be mailed to Families USA, ATTN: Health Action Conference, 1225 New York Ave, NW Ste. 800, Washington, DC, 20005 and must be received within 15 days of registration. Unpaid registration fees will result in cancellation of registration. If you register to pay by check after Friday, January 6, 2023, you must email your proof of in-process payment (such as a check copy or an approved payment request document) to the registration manager at HealthActionConference@FamiliesUSA.org.

HA2023 Cancellation and Refund Policy
